## **All Majors:**

Central Electric Cooperative Good Neighbor Scholarship <a href="https://www.central.coop/">https://www.central.coop/</a>

Scholarships awarded to members or children of members of CEC in good standing who are enrolled in any post-secondary educational institution. Requires letter of acceptance, letter of recommendation, and essay. Employees and directors of CEC, along with members of their immediate families, are not eligible. Applications available online through Central Electric Cooperative website.

## All Majors - For Graduating High School Seniors Only:

American Legion Lady's Auxiliary Scholarship (West Forest High School or Tidioute Community Charter School)

Open to graduating seniors from West Forest High School or Tidioute Community Charter School. Essay is required. Applications available through West Forest High School guidance office.

## Marsha L. Beichner Memorial Scholarship (East Forest High School)

Open to graduating seniors from East Forest High School who plan to attend a post-secondary school, including community college, two or four-year college degrees, technical school, trade school, and LPN or nursing programs. Applications available through East Forest High School guidance office.

Open to high school or college students from Venango, Clarion, Forest, or the Punxsutawney Area. Apply with one application on the Bridge Builders website.\*

#### Jeremy Coast Memorial Scholarship – 519 Strong

Awarded to graduating seniors from Venango, Clarion, Forest, and Mercer Counties. Applicants must plan to attend an accredited university, college, community college, or technical school. Essay is required. Applications available through guidance offices of high schools in Venango, Clarion, Forest, and Mercer Counties.\*

#### Katie M. Edmonson Memorial Scholarship (East Forest High School)

Open to graduating seniors from East Forest High School who plan to attend a post-secondary school, including community college, two-year or four-year degrees, and technical school. Applications available through East Forest High School guidance office.

#### Margery L. Himes Scholarship

Open to graduating seniors from Clarion, Venango, and Forest County Schools. Selection based on career path, financial need, likelihood of success in a college or trade school program, and community/extracurricular involvement. Applications available through guidance offices of high schools in Clarion, Venango, and Forest County.

#### General Joseph Warren Chapter DAR American History Essay Contest

All high school seniors enrolled in Warren and Forest County schools are eligible to apply. Requires essay. Applications available through West Forest High School guidance office.

#### Marienville Lions Club Scholarship (East Forest High School)

Up to \$1,500 scholarships awarded to a graduating seniors from East Forest High School. Essay is required. Applications available through East Forest High School guidance office.

## Oil City Lodge #78 Loyal Order of Moose Scholarship (West Forest High School)

Open to graduating seniors from West Forest High School who are natural, adopted, or stepchildren of a member of the Oil City Lodge #78 Loyal Order of Moose Club. Scholarships awarded based on need. Applications available through West Forest High School guidance office.

Veterans Club College and Trade School Scholarship (East Forest High School)
One \$500 scholarship awarded to a graduating senior from East Forest High School. Essay is required.
