access to needed early childhood education credentials and degrees.

WHEREAS, Early Childhood Educators need a mixed-delivery early childhood

education system of degrees and credentials that allows them to select

the setting that best meets their needs

WHEREAS, Early Childhood Educators need opportunities to acquire critical skills,

knowledge, and competencies through pathways to credentials and

higher education degrees, without incurring college debt.

THEREFORE, Be it resolved that the Northern Pennsylvania Regional College does

hereby proclaim April 10th -16th as

"Week of the Young Child"

AND AS SUCH, Does hereby recognize the complex, valuable, and demanding work of

early childhood educators;

Does hereby recognize that when our society helps educators, we also

help children and families; and

Declare that early childhood educators should be valued, respected,

and compensated for the important roles they play.
