The successful applicants will support and teach within the College's model of distributive teaching and learning, in which instruction is supported by technology, enabling students to engage in a single class experience from different locations through real-time interactive video feeds. The successful applicant will also be able to work effectively with supervisors, colleagues, staff, and students as part of an education team. Depending upon availability, the instructor could teach on-site customized training programs for corporate clients.

Specific Responsibilities:

- Availability to teach short-term classes in public classes or as customized training for corporate clients
- Develop and write course syllabi to include a course description, list of course objectives, textbook and related materials selection, list of learning and assessment activities, and a 20lesson course schedule
