  - If you/your parents did not file a 2018 tax return, but did work, submit a copy of all 2018 W2(s)
- Answer **both** of the following (include numbers for parents' household, if dependent):
  - Number of people in your parents' household (include yourself)
  - Number of people in parents' household attending college at least ½ time (include yourself)

## Minimum documentation requirements for Independent students:

- Provide the following for both you (and your spouse if married, and filed separately)
  - A signed copy of your 2018 federal Tax Return (Form1040) or a federal tax return transcript, available at https://www.irs.gov/individuals/get-transcript
  - If you did not file a 2018 federal tax return, submit a signed statement that you did not file a 2018 federal tax return and you (and your spouse if married) were not required to file a 2018 tax return
  - If you (and/or spouse if married) did <u>not</u> file a 2018 tax return but <u>did work</u>, submit a copy of 2018 W2(s)
  - If separated, provide a signed explanation of your current financial situation if it is different from your 2018 tax return, along with current paystubs and/or documentation of other income sources.
- Provide the following:
  - Number of people in your household (include yourself) \_\_\_\_\_ (only include your children/dependents and others for whom you provide over half of financial support)
  - Number in household indicated above attending college at least ½ time (include yourself)
