All Majors:

McGrady Family Scholarship Fund

Open to residents of Elk or Cameron Counties who are enrolled at Northern Pennsylvania Regional College and play active roles in their school or community. Applicants must be degree-seeking students who are taking classes at sites in Elk, Cameron, or Kane. Applications available through Elk County Community Foundation.

Vietnam Veterans of America Bucktail Ch. 720 Scholarship Program

Approximately \$1,000. Open to graduating seniors, college/technical school students, and past military personnel from the school districts of St. Marys, Johnsonburg, Ridgway, Brockway, Emporium, or DuBois. Applicant must be a relative of a Vietnam Veterans (living or deceased), and must submit an activity resume, SAT scores, and an essay. Applications available through guidance offices of high schools in the school districts listed.

All Majors – For Graduating High School Seniors Only:

Alcohol & Drug Abuse Services Video Scholarship

Approximately \$1,000. Open to graduating seniors planning to continue their education after high school. Applicants must submit a video that highlights the dangers of underage drinking or drunk driving. Additional information available through Cameron County High School guidance office.

Beaver-Lawrence Central Labor Council

Approximately \$1,000. Open to senior who is a union member, dependent child of a union member, or a grandchild residing in the home of a union member in good standing of a local union affiliated with the Beaver-Lawrence Central Labor Council. Applications available online through Beaver-Lawrence Central Labor Council website.

Cameron County Music Boosters (Cameron County High School)

Approximately \$500. Awarded to a graduating senior from Cameron County High School who participated in band, brand front, or chorus for at least 3 years, including senior year. Must display outstanding dedication to the music program. May be pursuing any degree, but special consideration may be given to students pursuing a degree in music. Applications available through Cameron County High School guidance office.

Cameron County Quarterback Club Scholarship (Cameron County High School)

Approximately \$250. Awarded to a graduating senior varsity football player from Cameron County High School who has participated in the football program from a minimum of 3 years of high school, including senior year. Applications available through Cameron County High School guidance office.

Christabelle Club Scholarship (Cameron County High School)

Approximately \$250 each awarded to two graduating seniors from Cameron County High School who are planning to attend two-year or four-year colleges. One or both parents must be social members of the Christabelle Club. Requires acceptance letter. Applications available through Cameron County High School guidance office.

Major Thomas E. Clark Memorial Scholarship (Cameron County High School)

Approximately \$100. Open to graduating seniors from Cameron County High School who plan to attend a two-year or four-year college, business, or technical school. Applicant must demonstrate service within the school and community. Requires two letters of recommendation. Applications available through Cameron County High School guidance office.

EHS/CCHS Alumni Association (Cameron County High School)

Approximately \$1,000. Open to graduating seniors from Cameron County High School who plan to pursue post-secondary education. Requires minimum 85% GPA and participation in extracurricular activities. Requires list of activities, two letters of recommendation, college acceptance letter, and statement of purpose. Applications available through Cameron County High School guidance office.

George B. & Helen M. Erskine Memorial Scholarship (Cameron County High School)

Open to graduating seniors from Cameron County High School who plan to pursue higher education. Applicant must show good moral character and financial need. Requires copy of parent's current year federal income tax return. Applications available through Cameron County High School guidance office.

Guy S. Felt & Mary Felt Educational Fund, John Schwab Foundation

Open to graduating seniors who are bona fide residents of Cameron County. Requires current federal income tax returns for parent/parents or legal guardians of the applicant. Applications available through Cameron County High School guidance office.

Nick Guisto Memorial Scholarship (Cameron County High School)

Approximately \$1,000. Open to graduating seniors from Cameron County High School who plan to attend a trade school, two-year, or four-year college. Applications available through Cameron County High School guidance office.

Thomas Gribble Memorial (Cameron County High School)

Approximately \$500. Open to graduating seniors from Cameron County High School or homeschoolers who are active participants of varsity baseball, softball, or volleyball for at least two seasons. Requires minimum 85% weighted GPA, activities resume, college acceptance letter, and letter of recommendation. Applicant should be accepted with plans of attending a two-year or four-year accredited college, trades school, or university. Applications available through Cameron County High School guidance office.*

Byron H. Horning, Jr. Memorial Scholarship (Cameron County High School)

Approximately \$1,000. Open to graduating seniors from Cameron County High School who intend to pursue higher education. Applications available through Cameron County High School guidance office.

Blair Hornung Memorial Scholarship (Cameron County High School)

Approximately \$500. Open to graduating seniors from Cameron County High School who participated in two varsity sports during their senior year and have been accepted into a two-year or four-year post-secondary program. Applicant must show financial need and academic merit. Applications available through Cameron County High School guidance office.

Dr. Hummel Award of Excellence (Cameron County High School)

Approximately \$100. Open to graduating seniors from Cameron County High School who plan to pursue higher education. Essay is required. Applications available through Cameron County High School guidance office.

Harriet Kennedy Horning EHS-CCHS Alumni (Cameron County High School)

Approximately \$250. Open to graduating seniors from Cameron County High School who plan to attend a two-year or four-year college, community college, technical, vocational, or trade school. Applications available through Cameron County High School guidance office.

Lady Raider Hoop Club (Cameron County High School)

Approximately \$250. Awarded to a senior female basketball player from Cameron County High School planning to further her education and is selected by her teammates.

Howard Mayberry Scholarship (Cameron County High School)

Approximately \$1,000. Open to graduating seniors from Cameron County High School who plan to pursue post-secondary education. Applicant must show strong financial need. Applications available through Cameron County High School guidance office.

May Hollow Sportsmens Club (Cameron County High School)

Approximately \$500. Awarded to a graduating senior from Cameron County High School planning to attend an accredited two-year or four-year college or university. Mother or father must be a member of the May Hollow Sportsmen's Club. Requires copy of college acceptance letter. Applications available through Cameron County High School guidance office.*

Mountain Laurel Federal Credit Union

Open to graduating seniors who are members of the Mountain Laurel Federal Credit Union and are planning to attend an accredited post-secondary college or vocational school. Seniors can join the credit union at the same time they apply. Essay is required. Applications available through Cameron County High School guidance office or online through the Mountain Laurel Federal Credit Union website.*

NAM Knights of America, Sergeant John C. Larose (Cameron County High School)

Approximately \$1,000. Open to graduating seniors from Cameron County High School who plan to attend an accredited two-year or four-year college, university, or trade school. Requires 80% minimum weighted GPA and essay. Applications available through Cameron County High School guidance office.*

Priest Family Scholarship (Cameron County High School)

Approximately \$1,000. Awarded to a graduating senior from Cameron County High School planning to attend a two or four-year college. Applicant must have excellent attendance record and be active in extracurricular activities. Requires minimum weighted GPA of 93%, essay, activities resume, and college acceptance letter. Applications available through Cameron County High School guidance office.

Gladys Schultz Memorial Scholarship (Cameron County High School)

Minimum \$500. Open to graduating seniors from Cameron County High School who show academic merit and financial need. Preference is given to students pursuing degrees in music or English. Applications available through Cameron County High School guidance office.

Approximately \$500. Awarded to a senior residing in Cameron, Elk, McKean, or Warren County who will be enrolled full-time as an undergraduate in the fall semester. Student must have been a member of the Mountain Laurel Federal Credit Union for at least 6 months prior to application deadline. Essay is required. Applications available through Cameron County High School guidance office or online through the Mountain Laurel Federal Credit Union website.

Student Transportation Scholarship (Cameron County High School)

Approximately \$1,000. Open to graduating seniors from Cameron County High School who plan to attend an accredited college or institution of higher education. Requires minimum 2.0 GPA for the previous two academic years. Applications available through Cameron County High School guidance office.*

Sylvan Heritage Council (Cameron County High School)

Approximately \$500. Open to graduating seniors from Cameron County High School who plan to attend an accredited two-year or four-year college or university. Requires minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA and participation in extracurricular activities. Requires letter of reference, activities resume, formal letter, and college acceptance letter. Applications available through Cameron County High School guidance office.*

Raider Hoop Club (Cameron County High School)

Approximately \$250. Awarded to a senior male basketball player from Cameron County High School who has been a varsity basketball player for two years and is planning to further his education. Recipient will be selected by teammates.

Janet Tucker Memorial Scholarship & John & Janet Howard Memorial Scholarship (Cameron County High School)

Approximately \$2,500. Open to graduating seniors from Cameron County High School who plan to attend a two-year or four-year college. Student must have attended Cameron County High School for at least 3 years and participated in at least one sport. Requires minimum "C" GPA. Applications available through Cameron County High School guidance office.

Applied Technology Students:

Armstrong County Technical School Scholarship

Open to high school seniors and adult students in Armstrong, Butler, Elk, or Cameron Counties who have a declared major in the trade arts. Requires 3.0 GPA. Essay is required. Applications available online through Armstrong County Community Foundation website.*

Embassy James Belbin Memorial (Cameron County High School)

Approximately \$500. Open to graduating seniors of Cameron County High School who plan to attend trade, technical, or four-year certificates or degrees in manufacturing fields including engineering, product design, electrician, machinist, drafting, welding, fabrication or other skills applied in a manufacturing environment. Essay is required. Applications available through Cameron County High School guidance office.

Rotary Club of Emporium Vocational/Technical Scholarship

Approximately \$1,000. Open to graduating high school seniors who plan to attend a vocational or technical school. Applicant must be active in extracurricular activities and have an excellent attendance record. Requires college acceptance letter, activity resume, and essay. Applications available through Cameron County High School guidance office or through the Rotary Club of Emporium.

Early Childhood Education Students:

PTO Woodland Elementary Scholarship (Cameron County High School)

Approximately \$500. Open to graduating high school seniors from Cameron County High School who plan to pursue degrees in the education field. Requires college acceptance letter and essay. Applications available through Cameron County High School guidance office.

General Education Certificate for University of Pittsburgh at Titusville

Nursing Program Students:

Cole Memorial Nursing Scholarship Program

Scholarships awarded to graduates of high schools within the Charles Cole Memorial Hospital service area and any area residents who have been accepted into an accredited registered nursing program.

Applications available through Cole Memorial Hospital.*

Penn Highlands Elk Auxiliary (St Marys, Ridgway, Elk County Catholic, Johnsonburg, or Cameron County High Schools)

Approximately \$500. Open to graduating seniors from St Marys Area High School, Ridgway High School, Elk County Catholic High School, Johnsonburg High School, or Cameron County High School who are accepted to attend advanced schooling in a medical related field. Requires recent volunteer work in the local area.
