Approximately \$1,000 each awarded to one female and one male graduating senior from Bradford Area High School. Applicant must be accepted and enrolled in an institution of higher learning. Requires an essay. Applications available through Bradford Area High School guidance office.

Minimum of \$500. Awarded to a graduating senior of Bradford Area High School who has attended Bradford Area High School for at least two full years. Applicant must be planning to enroll in an accredited two or four-year post-secondary school, business, trade school, or other program and must be involved in school and community activities. Requires activity resume or list of activities and achievements, minimum academic cumulative grade rating of the 75th percentile, essay, and three letters of recommendation. Applicant must show financial need and must not have been awarded more than two outside scholarships or financial incentives relative to their upcoming post-secondary studies, not counting this pending award. Bradford Area High School Key Club Member Scholarship (Bradford High School)

Awarded to a graduating senior from Bradford Area High School who is a member of the Key Club. Requires three letters of recommendation and essay. Applications available through Bradford Area High School guidance office.

Bradford High School and St. Bernard Classes of 1954 Scholarship (Bradford High School)

Approximately \$500 awarded to a graduating senior from Bradford Area High School. Requires list of activities and organizations. Applications available through Bradford Area High School guidance office.

Bradford Instrumental Music Scholarship (Bradford High School)

Two approximately \$500 scholarships awarded to graduating seniors from Bradford Area High School who have participated in an instrumental program for at least 2 years. Requires two letters of recommendation and list of extracurricular activities. Applications available through Bradford Area High School guidance office.

Bradford Ministerium Scholarship (Bradford High School)

Approximately \$250 awarded to a graduating senior from Bradford Area High School. Requires essay. Applications available through Bradford Area High School guidance office.

Bradford Public Schools Foundation Harry Lasky Scholarship (Bradford High School)

Awarded to a graduating senior from Bradford Area High School who is accepted to an institution of higher learning. Requires essay and Federal Income Tax form. Applications available through Bradford Area High School guidance office.

Bradford Union Lodge #749 Scholarship (Bradford High School)

Kane Eagles Helen Lathrop Memorial Scholarship (Kane High School)
