All Majors:

Fraternal Eagles of Warren, Aerie #313 Scholarship

Approximately \$1,000 awarded to Warren County residents who are accepted or attending a college, university, or technical school. Applications available through the Warren, Sheffield, Youngsville, Sugar Grove, and Tidioute libraries, or through the Eagles Club of Warren.

Jacob Levinson Family Scholarship Fund

Applicants must live within the Warren County School District and shall have graduated from one of the public high schools within the Warren County School District. Preference given to students planning a vocation in retailing, marketing, advertising, business management, or merchandising. Applicants must show scholastic aptitude, financial need, and good character. Requires copy of most recent income tax return, essay, and letter of recommendation. PNC Bank employees and their families are not eligible to apply. Applications available through guidance offices of high schools in Warren County School District.

Moose Family Center #109 Scholarships

Scholarships awarded to Warren County School graduates pursuing two or four-year degrees and/or certificate programs from accredited institutions. Awards are based on financial need, grades, and character. Applications available through guidance offices of high schools in Warren County School District.*

Jamie Woodburn/Retterer Scholarship

Applicant must be entering or currently enrolled in a college or university in an educational field of study. Requires proof of acceptance and essay. Applications available through Youngsville High School guidance office.

Merit-based scholarships are awarded to any person residing in Warren County with a high school diploma or GED who are furthering their education. Both traditional and non-traditional students are invited to apply. Requires two letters of recommendation and an essay. Applications available through Woman's Club of Warren website.

Scholarship up to \$1,000 awarded to an adult learner. Must be a current resident of Warren County who is enrolled in, or seeking acceptance to, a certificate or degree program. GED or high school diploma required. Requires most recent Federal Tax Return and proof of acceptance to a certificate or degree program. Applications available through Zonta Club website.

All Majors - For Graduating High School Seniors Only:

American Legion Post 135 Scholarship

Awarded to any Warren County School District senior who plans to pursue higher education. Requires three letters of recommendation, essay, and financial information. Applications available through guidance offices of high schools in the Warren County School District.

American Legion Post 658 Scholarship (Youngsville High School)

Awarded to a graduating Youngsville High School senior who plans to seek post-secondary education. Applications available through Youngsville High School guidance office.

Bill Anthony Memorial Scholarship

Awarded to a graduating senior who resides within the Zem Zem Shrine jurisdiction (Erie, Clarion, McKean, Mercer, Venango, or Warren Counties). Preference given to lineal descendants of members of Zem Zem Shrine or other Masonic organizations. Requires 2.0 minimum GPA and an essay. Applications available through guidance offices of high schools in Erie, Clarion, McKean, Mercer, Venango, and Warren Counties.

Jack and Judy Barner Memorial Scholarship (Sheffield High School or Kane High School) Scholarship awarded to a graduating student athlete at Sheffield Area High School or Kane Area High School. Selection based on academic achievement, activities and interests, and volunteer/extracurricular activities. Applications available through Sheffield Area High School guidance office.

Beaver-Lawrence Central Labor Council Scholarship

Open to graduating high school seniors who plan to pursue post-secondary education. Applicants must be a union member, dependent of a union member, or grandchild of a union member in good standing of a local union affiliated with the Beaver-Lawrence Central Labor Council AFL-CIO. Applications available through the Beaver-Lawrence Central Labor Council.

Oris Brown/Sheffield Lions Club Scholarship (Sheffield High School)

Awarded to a graduating senior from Sheffield Area High School. Selection based on student's ability in the classroom, academic achievement, and community involvement. Applications available through Sheffield Area High School guidance office.

Chautauqua Region Quilt Guild Sewing Education Scholarship

Awarded to a graduating senior. Requires list of volunteer activities and essay. Applications available through guidance offices of high schools in Warren County School District.

Clarendon VFW – Memorial Day Essay Contest

Essay is required. Applications available through guidance offices of high schools in Warren County School District.

Community Foundation of Warren County

The Community Foundation administers 23 scholarship funds annually. Scholarships are awarded to Warren County students pursuing college or trade school. Selection is based on financial need. Requires essay, letter of recommendation, and most recent Federal Income Tax Return. Apply directly on the Community Foundation of Warren County website.

Melissa M. Courtney Memorial Scholarship

Awarded to graduating seniors from Warren County School District high schools. Applicants are required to research answers to questions about the dangers of alcohol. Requires letter of acceptance from college or trade school. Applications available through guidance offices of high schools in Warren County School District.

Eagles Touchdown Club Football Scholarship (Youngsville High School)

Awarded to a graduating senior football player or cheerleader from Youngsville High School. Student must be associated with the football program for at least two years, at least one year must be their senior year. Requires two character references and documentation of acceptance at the school applicant will attend. Applications available through Youngsville High School guidance office.

General Joseph Warren Chapter DAR Essay Contest

All high school seniors enrolled in Warren and Forest County schools are eligible. Requires an essay. Applications available through guidance offices of high schools in Warren County School District.

Janet Henry Trust Scholarship

Awarded to graduating seniors residing in the former Brokenstraw attendance area. First preference is for applicants who plan to become librarians or secondary school teachers, though all are encouraged to apply. Applications available through Youngsville High School guidance office.

Jack & Judy Hoy Sr., 4-H Memorial Scholarship

Awarded to an outstanding 4-H horse club project member for their accomplishments in project knowledge, leadership skills, and cooperation with adults and younger members. Applications available through 4-H leaders.

Lewis Family Memorial Trust Scholarship (Sheffield High School)

Two scholarships awarded to graduating seniors from Sheffield Area High School. Priority given to those pursuing a degree in education or attending Pennsylvania College of Technology. Applications available through Sheffield Area High School guidance office.

Lindy Lydic Memorial Scholarship (Sheffield High School)

Awarded to one graduating Sheffield Area High School senior. Applications available through Sheffield Area High School guidance office.

Emory J. Mahan Memorial Scholarship (Sponsored by Warren County Republican Committee)

One award of \$1,000 to a graduating high school senior. Essay is required. Applications available through Warren County Republican Committee.

Mountain Laurel Federal Credit Union

Open to graduating seniors who are members of the Mountain Laurel Federal Credit Union and are planning to attend an accredited post-secondary college or vocational school. Seniors can join the credit union at the same time they apply. Essay is required. Applications available through guidance offices of Warren County high schools or online through the Mountain Laurel Federal Credit Union website.*

Rob Newton Scholarship Fund (International Union of Operating Engineers)

Sponsored by the International Union of Operating Engineers Local 95 of Warren, PA. The first scholarship will go to a graduating senior whose parent/guardian is a member of IUOE Local 95 at United Refining Company. The second will go to a graduating senior whose parent/guardian is a member of the IUOE Local 95 not employed by United Refining Company, or to a graduating senior whose parent/guardian is a member of the Warren County Central Labor Council of Warren. Essay is required. Applications available through guidance offices of high schools in Warren County School District.

Pauline Ongley Scholarship (Youngsville High School)

Open to graduating seniors from Youngsville High School. Applicant must have minimum cumulative GPA of 90%. Special consideration to students with financial need, a reference from part-time employment, a good reputation as a student, and plan to attend one of the member universities of the Pennsylvania State System of Higher Education. Requires essay and financial information. Applications available through Youngsville High School guidance office.

Pennsylvania Association of Community Bankers (PACB) Scholarship

Open to children of PACB employees. Northwest Savings Bank in Warren is a member of the PACB. Applications available through guidance offices of high schools in Warren County School District.

Pennsylvania Association of School Retirees Warren/Forest Chapter

Two scholarships of approximately \$450 each awarded to graduating seniors. Essay is required. Applications available through guidance offices of high schools in Warren County School District.

Pennsylvania Junior Wrestling Area VIII Scholarship

Scholarship for graduating Area VIII seniors who are planning to further their education. Applicant must have been involved with wrestling for at least three years, including cheerleaders, team managers, statisticians, photographers, and videographers. Applications available through Sheffield Area High School guidance office.

Anna J. Rickert Memorial Scholarship

Awarded to a child or stepchild of a union member in good standing with the Mercer County Central Labor Council's participating unions. Applications available through Sheffield Area High School guidance office.

Russell Volunteer Fire Department Scholarship

Applicant must be a permanent resident of Pine Grove Township and a high school senior. Applications available in guidance offices of high schools in Warren County School District.

Samuel Epstein Scholarship (Sheffield High School)

Applicant must be a graduating senior at Sheffield Area High School and have attended Sheffield Area High School for at least two years prior to graduation. Applicant must be accepted at a post-secondary institute in a program of at least two years. Essay is required. Applications available through Sheffield Area High School guidance office.

Sheffield Alumni Association Scholarship (Sheffield High School)

Awarded to a graduating senior of Sheffield Area High School. Applications available through Sheffield Area High School guidance office.

Sheffield Area Scholarship Fund (Sheffield High School)

Awarded to a graduating senior from Sheffield Area High School. Requires two letters of recommendation and an essay. Applications available through Sheffield Area High School guidance office.

Sheffield Music Boosters (Sheffield High School)

Scholarships awarded to graduating seniors from Sheffield Area High School who are active in the music program during their senior year. Applicant must have been an active member of the music program for a minimum of three years and must show proof of acceptance to an institute of higher learning. Applications available through Sheffield Area High School guidance office.

Sheffield Sports Boosters Athletic Scholarships (Sheffield High School)

Awarded to one male and one female graduating senior athlete from Sheffield Area High School. Applications available through Sheffield Area High School guidance office.

Approximately \$1,000 scholarship awarded to a graduating senior from Warren Area High School. Applicants must demonstrate involvement in community service activities throughout high school and show characteristics of leadership, intelligence, passion, and determination. Applicant must also show that they will fight for change against injustice. Applications available through Warren Area High School guidance office or online through the Community Foundation of Warren County website.

Approximately \$500. Awarded to a senior residing in Cameron, Elk, McKean, or Warren County who will be enrolled full-time as an undergraduate in the fall semester. Student must have been a member of the Mountain Laurel Federal Credit Union for at least 6 months prior to application deadline. Essay is required. Applications available through guidance offices of Warren County high schools or online through the Mountain Laurel Federal Credit Union website.

Warren County Board of REALTORS Scholarship

Awarded to a graduating senior who plans to attend any trade, technical, two-year, or four-year program. Applications available in the Youngsville High School guidance office.

Warren County Educational Support Personnel Association (WCESPA) Scholarship Open to all graduating seniors from the Warren County School District. Home and cyber school students are eligible to apply. Requires two essays. Applications available through guidance offices of high schools in the Warren County School District.

Warren County Victim Impact Panel Scholarship

Applicant must be a Warren County high school senior with a letter of acceptance from a college or trade school. Applicant must show leadership and positive role modeling while being alcohol and drug free. Essay is required. Applications available through guidance offices of high schools in Warren County School District.

Warren County Youth Football League

Open to senior football players from any Warren County high school who participated in the Warren County Youth Football League and continued to play football throughout junior and senior high school. Requires applicant to provide proof of acceptance into an institution of higher education and be enrolled in at least a two-year program. Selection based on academic achievements, cumulative GPA of at least 75%, school/community activities, and leadership/communication skills in school and on the football field. Application available through guidance offices of high schools in Warren County School District.

Warren County 4-H Development Council Scholarship

Open to a 4-H member or current volunteer screened leader who has been involved with the Warren County 4-H program for at least three years. Applications available through 4-H leaders.

Warren Sports Boosters Athletic Scholarship (Warren High School)

Two scholarships of approximately \$750 each awarded to one female and one male athlete from Warren Area High School. Requires minimum cumulative 75% GPA and participation in a minimum of three years of interscholastic sports activities. Applicant must have applied to an institution of higher education of two years duration or longer. Applications available through Warren Area High School guidance office.

Youngsville High School Alumni Scholarship (Youngsville High School)

Applicant must be a graduating Youngsville High School senior admitted to a college, university, or other school of advanced learning. Requires essay and list of three character references. Applications available through Youngsville High School guidance office.

Zavinski Scholarship Fund (Warren High School)

Open to any male or female graduating senior from Warren Area High School who has participated in a varsity sport during his or her senior year. Two essays are required. Applications available through Warren Area High School guidance office.

4-H Livestock Book Scholarship

Recognizes outstanding 4-H livestock project members for their accomplishments in project knowledge, animal husbandry skills, species knowledge, leadership skills, community service, and cooperation with adults and younger members. Applications available through 4-H leaders.

Business Administration Students:

Awarded to graduating high school seniors planning to seek a business-related degree from a college or university. Student must attend a high school in the ERIEBANK market area. One winner from each eligible high school will receive a \$500 scholarship. Dependents of directors or officers of ERIEBANK are not eligible to apply. Application available online through Erie Bank website.

Criminal Justice Students:

Timothy C. Walker Memorial Scholarship

Applicant must be a senior residing in Warren County who has applied to a criminal justice or criminology degree program at a college or university. Applicant cannot have a criminal record. Requires letter of acceptance and essay. Applications available through guidance offices of high schools in Warren County School District.

Early Childhood Education Students:

Melvin G. Keller and Mary F. Keller Scholarship Fund

Awarded to students majoring in education. Applicant must live within the area of the Warren County School District and must have graduated or will graduate from one of the public high schools in this district. PNC Bank employees and their families are not eligible to apply. Requires letter of recommendation, essay, and financial information. Applications available through guidance offices of high schools in Warren County School District.

Edith A. Langdale Scholarship Fund (Warren High School)

Awarded to a graduating senior from Warren Area High School who will major in elementary education or a related elementary field. PNC Bank employees and their families are not eligible to apply. Requires letter of recommendation, essay, and financial information. Applications available in the Warren Area High School guidance office.

Jessica C. Dean Memorial Scholarship (Youngsville High School)

Approximately \$1,000 awarded to a graduating Youngsville High School senior who will be majoring in early childhood or elementary education at two-year or four-year college. Selection based on school record, activities, and financial need. Applications available through Youngsville High School guidance office.

Jamie Woodburn/Retterer Scholarship

Open to any student entering or currently enrolled in an educational field of study. Applicants must show proof of acceptance or current enrollment in a college or university. Requires an essay. Applications available through Youngsville High School guidance office.

Approximately \$500. Open to graduating seniors, recent graduates, or adult learners in Elk, Warren, and Clearfield Counties. Applicant must be accepted into a post-secondary institution pursuing an RN or BSN degree. Requires 2.5 minimum GPA. Applications available online through Elk County Foundation website. High school students must apply through their guidance office.

Warren General Hospital Auxiliary Health Care Scholarship

Scholarships available to any Warren County student enrolled full time in courses leading to certification and/or licensure in a health care field. Requires letter to Auxiliary Board. More information available through Warren General Hospital Auxiliary.

*Requires college is accredited. Make sure NPRC is eligible before applying.
