Margaret I. Fiely Scholarship (Titusville High School)

Scholarship awarded to assist with educational expenses for a non-traditional female student who graduated from Titusville High School and has been accepted to the University of Pittsburgh at Titusville or other programs held on Pitt-Titusville campus (including NPRC). Second priority is given to a current female graduating senior at THS who is planning to attend Pitt-Titusville or another program held on Pitt-Titusville campus (including NPRC).
