Subject: Suspension and Expulsion

1. PURPOSE

This policy establishes the consequences for suspension and expulsion from the college.

2. SCOPE AND APPLICABILITY

This policy is applicable to all students.

4. DEFINITIONS - None

5. POLICY

5.1 Suspension is the temporary separation of a student from the College for violation of college policy. A penalty of Suspension shall result in the following:

- 5.1.1 Suspended students are ineligible to attend any event, function, or class provided by the College other than a meeting or hearing related to the Suspension for a defined period.
- 5.1.2 In cases where the suspension prevents coursework, the College shall issue a grade of W indicating administrative withdrawal from the course(s) in which the student was enrolled.
- 5.1.3 Suspended students may be ineligible for any refund of tuition or fees and must meet all conditions for readmission stated in the order of Suspension.
- 5.1.4 Following the suspension, students may re-apply for admission to the college.

5.2 Expulsion is the permanent separation of a student from the College. A penalty of Expulsion shall result in the following:

- 5.2.1 Expelled students may not attend any College event or instructional activity other than a meeting related to the Expulsion.

- 5.2.2 Expelled students will receive a grade of W indicating administrative withdrawal from the course(s) in which the student was enrolled during the semester in which they were enrolled.
- 5.2.3 Expelled students may be ineligible for any refund of tuition or fees.
- 5.2.4 Expelled students are ineligible for readmission to the College.

5.3 Suspensions and/or Expulsion are part of a student’s permanent educational record and are released to any institution to which the student requests their NPRC official transcript or educational record be sent.

6. RESPONSIBILITIES AND TIMELINES

The Vice President for Academic and Student Affairs is responsible for oversight of this policy.
