

## NPRC Retention

Please note that NPRC calculates retention using the institutional definition of retention: having a student continue enrollment from one academic year to the next academic year in at least one term thus maintaining their catalog of record, excluding graduates. It is also of note that NPRC became an independent institution during the spring term of 2020, therefore, the 2019-20 data excludes the fall 2019 term.

The national definition is as follows: retaining a student from fall of one academic term to fall of the following academic year, excluding graduates. This generally refers to first-time, full-time degree-seeking students. NPRC's retention following the national definition is also calculated below, however, please note that these numbers are pre-census for the Fall 2021 academic term.
